REMINDERS FROM THE NURSE



6th Grade Physical Examinations: The school nurse will accept a completed physical examination from up to one year prior to the first day of school this year or at any time during the sixth-grade year. A copy of the child's immunization record must be completed and turned in with the physical. **Remember that exclusion day is September 4, 2024. Any student going into 7th grade without documented TDAP and Meningococcal vaccines, an exemption on file, or a med cert (documented upcoming doctor appointment on file with the school nurse) will be excluded from school until one of these three things are obtained.

7th Grade Dental: The school nurse will accept a dental form dated from up to one year prior to the school start date or anytime during their seventh-grade year. It is a state requirement that every student in 7th grade must have a dental exam. All physical/dental forms can be picked up in the main office or downloaded from the district website.

These completed forms may be turned into the main office over the summer on Monday - Thursday 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. or faxed from doctor's office to 717-242-5805.

CLASSROOM SPOTLIGHT: MRS. HARTMAN'S 6TH GRADE SCIENCE

2024 MCSD SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

WHO: Students in grades 6-12 who failed a course(s) during the 2023-2024 school year.

APPLICATIONS: The application process <u>begins at the MCMS guidance office</u>. The student's school counselor, Mrs. Foor (6th graders) jaf28@mcsdk12.org and Mr. McCardell (7th graders) alm21@mcsdk12.org will help with determining eligibility for summer school. The counselor will also need to complete part of the registration form. <u>Applications will be accepted through June 24</u>, however, students may begin prior to the 24th, once an application is received and payment is made.

DATES: In-person session days will be on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., beginning on Tuesday, June 25th and ending on Thursday, July 18th. Attendance at the facility is not required to complete the coursework. Daily attendance is recommended though, as staff members will be available during these hours to assist students.

COST: The cost per course is \$150.00. Payment must be made prior to a course becoming available to the student. Checks can be made out to "MCSD" and should be given to the Alpha staff at MCHS when enrolling the student.

CURRICULUM: Most curricula will be self-paced online courses accessible online 24/7 by the student. Some courses may also be offered as an independent study with a curriculum developed by the MCSD Summer School staff.

LOCATION: The Alpha classroom, Room C207, 2nd floor, "C" wing of the Mifflin County High School will be the Summer School facility for students in grades 6-12. The Summer School entrance is at Door 18 via the buzzer at the rear of MCHS.

COMMITMENT: Students must be aware of and adhere to all rules and regulations contained in the 2023-2024 MCSD Secondary Student Handbook and the 2024 Summer School Handbook.

TRANSPORTATION: All students must provide their own transportation.
