Mobile Ag Day








On September 22, the Ag mobile pulled in for its yearly visit to EDES. During the week all classes participated in two different hands-on Ag science lessons in the mobile classroom. Students applied the scientific method to complete science experiments that made connections to Agriculture and its importance in our daily lives. Lessons covered were Farm Charm, Crawly Critters, Thirsty Stem, Glue from Milk, Little Red Hen, Bee-utiful Relationship, Popcorn Caper and No Soil, Now What. <u> School Bus Safety Week</u>

October 21 - 25 is National School Bus Safety Week.

SAFETY FIRST, SAFETY ALWAYS

- Stay at least 10 feet (five giant steps) away from the curb while you wait.
- Always wait for the bus to stop completely and the driver to signal it's time to get on board.
- F Face forward once you're in your seat.
- Exit the bus after it stops completely. Always cross in front of the bus, once the driver signals that it's safe to do so.

Bus Stop Reminder: Kindergarten students MUST have an adult at the bus stop. If an adult is not present, the student will NOT be permitted to get off the bus and will be taken to the bus garage where they will need to be picked up.

Educational Trip

Students are able to take up to 5 Educational Trip days per school year. Parent/Guardian must complete a form and have it approved by a principal and students' teacher prior to taking the trip. A report is due to the office within 3-5 days of returning from the trip for it to be considered a lawful absence.

—When staff sees students who are being Respectful, Responsible, Ready, and Safe, they are given a PAW TICKET. When students are awarded with a paw ticket, they place their name on it and place it in a bucket. Paw Tickets are randomly drawn from the buckets at the end of the week to win a prize.

Students & staff have a goal for earning Paw Tickets. When the goal is reached, there is a SURPRISE celebration.

Classroom teachers and select staff are given a GOLDEN PAW TICKET to give out each marking period. Golden Paw Tickets are warded to students that consistently demonstrate respectful, responsible, ready, and safe behavior.
