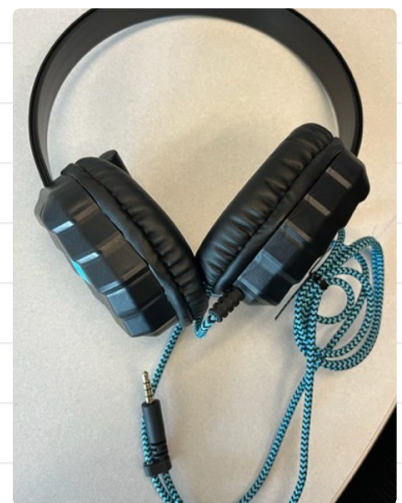
From the Principal's desk...

Headphones🎧

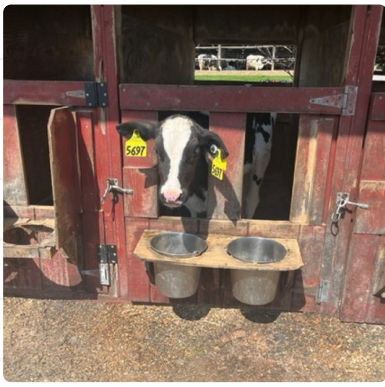
