IVEC Ski Club trips to Tussey Mountain are scheduled for the following dates:

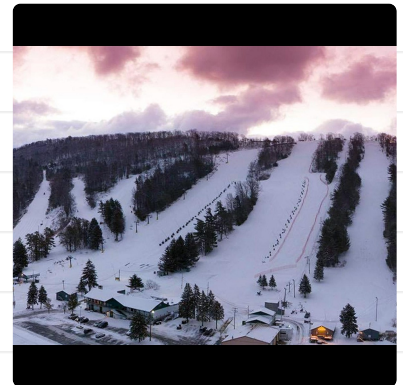
