#### **SKYLERT**

#### **FAMILY ACCESS**

You can access your child's transportation arrangements, grades, Skylert information and more via Family Access.

#### **PBIS**

The four core behaviors staff will be teaching and looking to acknowledge include being RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE, READY AND SAFE!

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Students arriving after 8:20 AM are tardy.

Students arriving after 9:30 AM or leaving before 2:00 PM will be marked absent for ½ of a day.

Excuses must be returned within three (3) days of an absence.

Excuses should include the student's full name, the date of and reason for absence, and a parent/guardian signature.

### **TRANSPORTATION**

If a student will not be riding the bus, submit a written note with the student's full name, the time of pick-up, and who will be picking up the student.

Please park in the parking lot or along Green Avenue during drop-off/dismissal.

Please DO NOT park or drop-off/pick-up students along Kish Street, in the Bus Lane or at the "Maintenance Shed" at the end of Kish Street.

Remain in your vehicle during dismissal.

Afternoon dismissal begins at 2:45 PM. Pick-ups/walkers will be dismissed at 2:50 PM.
