Mifflin County High School offers seniors a variety of scholarship options. Whether a student is attending a 4 year college or university, a 2 year college, a trade/technical school, or a certificate program, there are local scholarships available to help ease the cost of tuition. Each scholarship has its own set of eligibility and application requirements. Seniors are encouraged to check the scholarship wall frequently from January until May.

Aaron Bossinger Memorial Scholarship: Aaron Bossinger was one of the finest musicians to hail from Mifflin County and dedicated his life to his love for music, learning about music, and teaching music to others. This award is given in his memory.

Debra Tate-Anderson Scholarship: Debra Tate-Anderson was a beloved Art teacher in the Mifflin County School District who lost her battle with cancer in 2016.
